

The Busch Wildlife Sanctuary

The Busch Wildlife Sanctuary is a non-profit organization dedicated to the protection and conservation of Florida's wildlife and natural resources. This educational based injured wildlife care facility is designed to bring wildlife and people together to develop community awareness of the value and diversity of Florida's unique ecosystems and wild creatures.

The Busch Sanctuary was originally established in 1983 with the main mission of caring for sick, injured, and orphaned wild animals with the added goal of promoting wildlife and habitat conservation, through a variety of community environmental outreach programs.

In 1997, through the generous support of the Peter W. Busch Family Foundation, the Busch Wildlife Sanctuary's community nature center opened its doors to the public. Today, the Sanctuary provides free comprehensive medical and rehabilitative care to over 4,300 injured

wild animals each year. Under the direction of a qualified medical staff, animals are rehabilitated with the ultimate goal of returning recovered patients to their natural habitats.

The Sanctuary offers visitors a one-of-a-kind opportunity to learn about Florida's wildlife and natural environments. More than just a "zoo" exhibiting caged animals,



this unique refuge combines a nature center with a wildlife hospital. Over 100,000 children and adults visit the Sanctuary each year and participate in educational programs that offer a rare opportunity to learn from nature up-close while creating a memorable message of respect for all living creatures and their habitats.

Nature trails at the Sanctuary lead visitors through pine flatwoods, oak hammocks, and cypress wetlands. Along the trails are wildlife habitats exhibiting a variety of native animals from bald eagles to Florida panthers, otters, foxes, crocodiles, deer, and more.



To complement Sanctuary's outdoor exhibits, visitors can enjoy a hands-on discovery center where they may explore nature through a variety of interactive displays; the discovery center also includes a classroom, library, and gift shop. The Cypress Amphitheater provides the perfect backdrop for regularly scheduled wildlife presentations and special events.
